

WSYSA State Tournaments

State Tournament Roster additions, releases, transfers and Cup Tied information and freeze dates.

Dairy Farmers of Washington President's Cup - No transfers to the team for the sole purpose of tournament play or guest players will be allowed. Any additions are subject to the approval of the WSYSA State Registrar, WSYSA President's Cup Tournament Director and the WSYSA VP of Recreation. No roster can be adjusted after play commences in the requesting team's District. Updates to the adult staff may be allowed. Check with your association registrar for more information.

Fred Meyer Commissioners' Cup - U11 teams may carry up to a maximum of 14 players on their roster while U12 and above may carry up to 18. Teams must have a minimum of 9 players registered to the team from the time of initial September 2006 fall team registration. The remaining 9 open positions may be filled by adding 9 new players or transferring 9 players or any combination thereof. WSYSA will accept roster additions, releases and transfers up to a roster freeze date set annually by the Tournament Director. Any transfers submitted after the application deadline date will not be accepted for any player whose team is in the Fred Meyer Commissioners' Tournament. Teams wishing to make changes to their tournament roster after the November 15th entry deadline may do so up to the roster freeze date by contacting their association registrar. The roster freeze date will be posted to the WSYSA web.

Challenge Cup - U11 teams may carry up to a maximum of 14 players on their roster while U12 and above may carry up to 18. Teams must have a minimum of 9 players registered to the team from the time of initial September 2006 fall team registration. The remaining 9 open positions may be filled by adding 9 new players or transferring 9 players or any combination thereof. WSYSA will accept roster additions, releases and transfers up to a roster freeze date set annually by the Tournament Director. Any transfers submitted after the application deadline date will not be accepted for any player whose team is in the Challenge Cup Tournament. Teams wishing to make changes to their tournament roster after the November 15th entry deadline may do so up to the roster freeze date by contacting their association registrar. The roster freeze date will be posted to the WSYSA web

US Youth Soccer Washington State Championships - U12-U16 teams entering the State Championships may have a maximum of 18 players on their roster. U17-U19 teams entering the State Championships may have a maximum of 22 players on their roster. Each team must have a minimum of 9 players registered to the team from the time of the initial August 1st 2006 fall team registration. The remaining open positions on the roster may be filled by adding new players and/or transferring of players. Per US Youth Soccer National Championships series Rule 221 Section 2. (a) 1. *A team may not roster any player who was previously rostered during the seasonal year to another team, or the same team, unless a written request, stating the reason why this action has been requested, has been made to and approved by the State Association on a form provided. At the time a team names its National Championship roster it may not have more than 5 previously rostered players.* In simple terms this means that once the rosters are frozen prior to the gender age groups first tournament games, the teams final tournament roster may have no more than 5 player's rostered to the team via a transfer.

Cup Tied - Players rostered on U17, U18 and U19 teams entered into the US Youth Soccer Washington State Championships become "tied" to that specific Championships team as of the tournament draw date. The Tournament Director will set the draw date for early December. The Draw date and time will be posted on the WSYSA web site. Cup tied simply means that once the draw is completed for the brackets, all players rostered to a team must play with this team if they wish to play in the Championship Cup. Players on a U17, U18 or U19 Championships roster may not move to another team within the Championships Tournament after the draw. The team may continue to fill their roster by transferring players to their team from teams in other state tournaments, from the player pool or even from teams not participating in any of the state tournaments. Cup Tied does not apply to the U12-U16 age groups.

Roster changes will be accepted up to the roster freeze date of 14 days prior to the first tournament game of the specific gender and age group. This date is set annually by the National Championships Tournament and the WSYSA State Tournament Director. Teams wishing to make changes to their tournament roster after the November 15th entry deadline may do so up to the roster freeze date by contacting their association registrar. The roster freeze date will be posted to the WSYSA web.
